Subject: Scholarships for Students with Disabilities - Opening of National Scholarship Portal (NSP) for FY-2020-21.

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwD) is implementing three scholarships for students with disabilities through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP): (a) Pre-matric scholarships for Class IX and X (b) Post-matric scholarships for Class XI to Post-graduation (c) Scholarship for Top Class Education for Graduate/Post Graduate Degree or Diploma in 241 notified institutions.

2. The registration of students on the NSP has started from **16<sup>th</sup> August 2020** for Fresh Application registration and **21<sup>st</sup> August 2020** for renewal applications on [website- www.scholarships.gov.in](http://www.scholarships.gov.in). The details of these schemes are available on the website of this Department ([www.disabilityaffairs.gov.in](http://www.disabilityaffairs.gov.in)). The last date for registration and submission of application by the students is **31<sup>st</sup> October 2020**. Following are the timelines finalized for submission and verification of applications on the National Scholarship Portal:-

3. After the student submits on-line application, the school/ institute/college will verify the applications online. For verifying the applications, the institute/school/college, must

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complete their registration form and get it verified from District/State Nodal Officer failing which the institute/school/college will not be able to verify the applications online. Those Institute/Schools with valid AISHE/ DISE code can only register on NSP Portal. Also, from the FY 2020-21 the fee components viz. Tuition Fee, admission Fee and Miscellaneous Fee will be filled by the institution itself on the portal and not by the student. The fee component to be filled by the institute will be available on frequently asked questions (FAQ) on the website of this Department and also uploaded on the NSP home page shortly.


4. After first level verification i.e., the institute/college/school, the State Nodal Officer concerned is required to verify the applications on-line. The State Nodal Officers may ensure timely registration and verification of institute/schools/ colleges under their jurisdiction. After verification of applications, the State Nodal Officer will digitally sign to verify students on NSP Portal instead of on the PFMS Portal. The State Nodal Officers have already been informed vide this Department's letter of even number dated 24.8.2020 (copy enclosed).

5. The payment of the scholarship amount is made through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode in the beneficiary's bank account. The number of scholarships allotted to each State/UT in Pre-matric, Post-matric and Top Class Education is in accordance with the proportion of PwD population of that State/UT in proportion to the total PwD population of India (**copy attached**). District/State Nodal Officer is expected to retain a copy of the duly authenticated online form received from the institute/college/school. The Institute Nodal Officer is also required to retain the hard copy of student's verified documents in their custody.

6. State Nodal Officers/Institutes/Students may check the updates/notifications on the NSP, as all the notification/updates will be flashed on the homepage of National Scholarship Portal.

7. You are requested to co-ordinate with the Education Department of your State/UTs to issue suitable instructions to Institutes/District level authorities to mobilize students. Awareness may also be disseminated through advertisements by the State Government and on the web-site of Social Welfare Department so that students with disabilities are not deprived of the benefits under the scheme.
