## Jan - Feb 2022 - B.E. Semester V - VIII (RC 2019-20, RC 2016-17 & RC 2007-08)

All the eligible B.E. students of all Engineering branches appearing for the examination of Sem. V to VIII (RC 2019-20, RC 2016-17 & RC 2007-08) in the month of Jan – Feb 2022 are hereby informed to register online for respective semester examination from 23/11/2021 to 30/11/21. ## **Steps to follow for Exam Registration.**

Login with your credentials- Use Your Roll Number as **Username** & for **password** Enter First three letter of your name as per HSSC marks card followed by date of birth ( if password not changed earlier).

If your name as per HSSC marks card is Desai Vijay and DOB is 13 Nov 2001, then your password will be **DES13112001** ((First three letter should be in capital)

Students shall register for examination in <u>EXAM → TRANSCATION</u> → HIGHER SEM EXAM REGISTRATION

- 1. Students admitted under general category and seeking exam fees concession under SC/ST/OBC category need to contact Academic Section with hard copy of valid caste certificate before online exam registration. DURING COVID-19 PLEASE EMAIL SCAN COPY OF CASTE CERTIFICATE TO enquiry@gec.ac.in. (Kindly mention email subject as "Exam Fees concession")
- 2. For any queries students shall contact Academic section on 0832-2336406 or send email on <a href="mailto:enquiry@gec.ac.in">enquiry@gec.ac.in</a> (email sent on any other email id will not be considered) on or before last notified date.
- 3. Students shall pay exam fees online at the time of registration, before last notified date. It is advised to view help files before making online payments.
- 4. Students can change the registration details before payment of exam fees.
- 5. Online exam registration /application will be freezed after payment of exam registration fees.
- 6. The registration details can be viewed under exam registration slip.
- 7. Students are advised to generate exam registration slip after payment of exam registration fees and save the softcopy for the reference. (Do not submit registration slip in the academic section)
